The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following item(s) at 6:00 p.m., after regular business, on Monday, June 5, 2023, in the Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, 1 Woolfolk Ave., Louisa, Virginia:

Public Hearing – Amendments to Chapter 78 Utilities of the Louisa County Code of Ordinances

The proposed amendment to Louisa County’s Chapter 78 Utilities will add language to include the Water Supply Emergency Ordinance §§ 78-500 through 78-510 to the existing ordinance. This amendment will provide for the necessary curtailment of water usage through voluntary and mandatory restrictions during a water supply shortage affecting portions of Louisa County that are served in whole or in part by the Louisa County Water Authority.

Public Hearing – Amending Article I, Section 2-4 (3) and (4)- Election Precincts

The proposed amendment to Louisa County’s Code adds language to add a voter satellite office located at 103 McDonald Street, Louisa Virginia 23039 for the purpose of absentee voting, and the addition of Section 2-4(4) of the Code of the County of Louisa Virginia, Central Absentee Voting Precinct to affect the relocation of the Registrar’s Office to 103 McDonald Street, Louisa, Virginia 23093, estimated to take place in July of 2023.
